

Different kinds of bait for the Oilwind Baiting System

Mackerel

These parts must be cut off, so you only put the fillet in the bait cutter.



When using mackerel, you need to cut it in half as shown here, before you put it in the bait cutter.



The bait must be fully defrosted, before you start setting the line out.

Herring

These parts must be cut off, so you only put the fillet in the bait cutter.



Now is the herring cut in two parts, ready to put into the bait cutter.



The bait must be fully defrosted, before you start setting the line out.

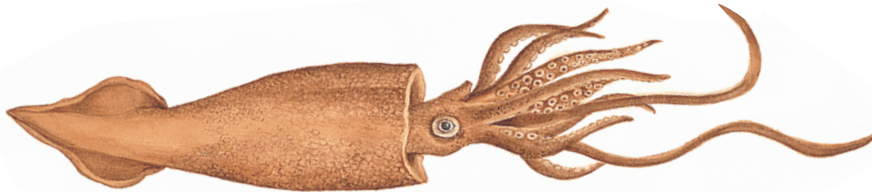
Saury
